RULES AND CONDITIONS – Saturday 20th May 2017

1. This competition is registered with the South Queensland Regional Committee of Highland Dancing Inc. Reg. No. SQC 17/04 & C 09/2017 and will be conducted under the rules and conditions as set down by SOBHD and adopted by ABHDI.
2. Dancers must be registered and present registration card on the day of competition.
3. Age to be taken as at date of competition (SQC 17/04 – 20/05/2017).
4. Dancers are to compete in their own age group and one classification only.
5. First to enter, last to dance.
6. **PRE-PREMIER** - Eligibility for Pre-Premier section will apply as at date of competition and shall be in accordance with SOBHD registration scheme.
7. **PREMIER WITH RESTRICTION** – These dances are restricted to Premier dancers who have not been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a Registered Championship since 20/05/2014. Dancers may compete in Premier with Restriction dances or Premier dances, but cannot compete in both.
8. **MORETON BAY PRE-CHAMPIONSHIP** – Entry is restricted to those PREMIER dancers who have never won a Championship or a Pre-Championship.
9. **TITLES** – Dancers may choose not to compete in all dances that make up the title and still be eligible for an overall title prize, however, the full title fee still applies.
10. Dancers compete entirely at their own risk.
11. Dancers arriving late for a section will not be allowed to compete if the dance has been completed. Alternatively, competitors may not pre-dance prior to the commencement of a section.
12. Dancers must 'fill in' if requested by the organiser. If a competitor fails to fill in unless for a medical reason the organiser has the right to enforce Rule 1g), Page 42 D-Judges, SOBHD Rules and Regulations, which reads: 'Provided due prominence is given to the fact in the programme or in a brochure by the Organiser, then during the course of a competition the comportment of the competitors may come under the jurisdiction of the judges, not only whilst dancing, but also when entering or leaving the platform and whilst waiting for the dance to start. Any unseemly behaviour on the part of the competitor or any misdemeanour likely to upset the decorum of the proceedings may be penalised by the judges and could lead to disqualification, but a full report of any such misconduct on the part of a competitor must be submitted by the judges to the organiser'.
13. Dancers entering sections when ineligible shall forfeit their entry fee.
14. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries, substitute an Adjudicator and/or alter the program at their discretion.
15. Adjudicator Rachel Bonus will only officiate over sections containing dancers aged under 16 years in both Session 1 & Session 2.
16. Subject to the official protest ruling, the Judge's decision is final.
17. Any complaint made by an individual against the organisation or the adjudication of an event must be in writing stating the complainant's full name and address and be lodged with the organiser, if possible on the day of the event, and no later than 48 hours after the event. Such a complaint is to be accompanied by a fee of \$5.00, which is refundable if the protest is upheld.
18. For presentation of prizes, dancers must be in Kilt or National Costume. Competition numbers must be worn for prize giving ceremony. For presentation of Moreton Bay Pre-Championship, dancers must be dressed in Kilt, wearing their Pre-Championship number.
19. Video equipment and Photography – **DEFINITELY NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY** is allowed whilst dancers are competing. Videoing is permitted with the following proviso – Only own child or pupil can be filmed and at no time will the film or video be accepted as evidence when protesting judging.
20. If after submitting an entry a competitor changes classification, the Entries Secretary must be notified, as soon as practicable, **PRIOR** to competition day.
21. Any rules pertaining to the competition and/or championship released from SOBHD and ABHDI from time of printing this schedule and actual date of competition will be adhered to.
22. Competitors must use the official music and swords provided by the committee.
23. No warm-up or practicing is permitted inside the hall whilst dancers are competing.
24. Smoking is not permitted inside the hall or whilst inside the School Grounds.
25. Dancers are requested to observe the ABHDI direction regarding standard of dress whilst in attendance at Highland Dancing Competitions. If dancers choose to remove any part of their costume whilst not competing, it is requested they be modestly attired at all times.
26. Scotia Highland Dancing Studio is not liable for the safety of unaccompanied dancers and unsupervised non-dancers.
27. Scotia Highland Dancing Studio's Risk Management Strategy will be in force and will be available for anyone who wishes to peruse this document.
28. Refunds will only be given on production of a medical certificate and if the Competition Secretary is advised in writing prior to the event. No refunds will be given if a dancer does not meet the criteria above or does not compete on the day.
29. Scotia Highland Dancing Studio reserves the right to deal with any matter not covered by these rules.
30. All Perpetual Trophy winners will be required to sign for these trophies and must abide by the stated conditions as laid out in the terms and conditions document provided at the competition.

RULES AND CONDITIONS – Sunday 21st May 2017

1. This competition is registered with the South Queensland Regional Committee of Highland Dancing Inc. Reg. No. SQC 17/05 & C 09/2017 and will be conducted under the rules and conditions as set down by SOBHD and adopted by ABHDI.
2. Dancers must be registered and present registration card on the day of competition.
3. Age to be taken as at date of competition (SQC 17/05 – 21/05/2017).
4. Dancers are to compete in their own age group and one classification only.
5. First to enter, last to dance.
6. **PRE-PREMIER** - Eligibility for Pre-Premier section will apply as at date of competition and shall be in accordance with SOBHD registration scheme.
7. Dancers compete entirely at their own risk.
8. Dancers arriving late for a section will not be allowed to compete if the dance has been completed. Alternatively, competitors may not pre-dance prior to the commencement of a section.
9. Dancers must 'fill in' if requested by the organiser. If a competitor fails to fill in unless for a medical reason the organiser has the right to enforce Rule 1g), Page 42 D-Judges, SOBHD Rules and Regulations, which reads: 'Provided due prominence is given to the fact in the programme or in a brochure by the Organiser, then during the course of a competition the comportment of the competitors may come under the jurisdiction of the judges, not only whilst dancing, but also when entering or leaving the platform and whilst waiting for the dance to start. Any complaint made by an individual against the organisation or the adjudication of an event must be in writing stating the complainant's full name and address and be lodged with the organiser, if possible on the day of the event, and no later than 48 hours after the event. Such a complaint is to be accompanied by a fee of \$5.00, which is refundable if the protest is upheld.
15. In each age group within the Beginners, Novice and Intermediate classification, an aggregate trophy will be awarded. To be eligible, competitors do not have to dance in all relevant section dances in their age group. Points will be awarded according to placings given on the basis of:
1st - 137 pts, 2nd - 91pts, 3rd - 71pts, 4th - 53pts, 5th - 37pts, 6th - 23pts.
16. For presentation of prizes, dancers must be in Kilt or National Costume. Competition numbers must be worn for prize giving ceremony. For presentation of Moreton Bay Championships, dancers must be dressed in Kilt, wearing their Championship number.
17. Video equipment and Photography – **DEFINITELY NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY** is allowed whilst dancers are competing. Videoing is permitted with the following proviso – Only own child or pupil can be filmed and at no time will the film or video be accepted as evidence when protesting judging.
