South Queensland St. Andrew's Day Championships & Darling Downs Competition and Titles

DARLING DOWNS COMPETITION

*Beginners, Novice & Intermediate dancers commencing at 1:00pm with Scottish Lilt.

*Primary dancers required at approximately 1:30pm.

*Premier dancers commencing approximately 3:30pm with 4 step Blue Bonnets

Individual places: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th (if entries allow) Overall Placegetters: 1st, 2nd, 3rd

Beginners Section Supporting Events: Trophy Highland Fling (4), Sword Dance (2 & 1), Seann Triubhas (3 & 1)

Novice Section Supporting Events: Trophy Highland Fling (5), Sword Dance (2 & 1), Seann Triubhas (3 & 1)

Intermediate Section Supporting Events: Sailors' Hornpipe (4), Barracks Johnnie (4), Irish Jig (3 & 1),
Special Dance – Highland Laddie (4)

Premier Section Supporting Events: Earl Of Errol (4), Village Maid (4), Scotch Measure (4),

Premier Special Dance with Restriction – Blue Bonnets (5): this is open to Premier dancers who have not won 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a Registered Championship since 2013

Premier Special Dance – Blue Bonnets (4): this special dance is open to all Premier dancers. **Dancers are reminded of the 8 dance rule.**

South Queensland Registrar, Glenys Hughes will be available to take 2019 registrations on the day and to sight date of birth documentation, if necessary.

COMPETITION RULES

1. This competition is registered with the South Queensland Regional Committee of Highland Dancing Inc (S.Q.R.C.H.D.I.) – Reg.No. SQC 18/05 and C22/2018. This competition will be conducted under the rules and conditions of the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing (S.O.B.H.D) and as adopted by the Australian Board of Highland Dancing Inc (A.B.H.D.I.).
2. Dancers must be registered and present their registration card on day of competition.
3. Age to be taken as at the date of the competition. Competitors must be prepared to show proof of age.
4. Dancers are to compete in their own age group and in one classification only. If, after submitting an entry, a competitor changes classification, the COMPETITION SECRETARY must be notified of the change PRIOR to the competition date (24th November, 2018).
5. Any complaint made by an individual against the organisation or adjudication of an event must be made in writing, giving the complainants full name and address, and shall be lodged with the organiser (if possible on the day of the event) not later than 48 hours after the event. The complaint must be accompanied by a fee of \$5.00 which is refundable if the protest is upheld.
6. Subject to the official protest rule above, the Adjudicator's decision is final.
7. Dancers compete entirely at their own risk.
8. All competitors must use the official music and swords provided by the Competition Organiser.
9. Competitors not ready when called forfeit the right to compete. Competitors arriving late for a section will not be allowed to compete if the section dance has been completed. Likewise, competitors may not pre-dance prior to the commencement of the section.
10. Teachers, interested parties or any other unauthorised person must not communicate with judges during the competition or Championships. All enquiries must be made at the official table.
11. A competitor who has taken part in any so called Championship not recognised by the Board or any person who has acted as a judge at such an event, shall be ineligible to compete or judge in any recognised Championship or Competition under SOBHD rules until given permission to do so by the Board.
12. Competitors do not have to remain in the marshalling area for the Championships but must return for the correct order of ballot. The onus is on the competitor to return in time for the correct order of ballot.
13. Dancers must "fill in" if requested by the organiser. If a competitor fails to fill in unless for a medical reason the organiser has the right to enforce Rule 1g), Pg. 44 D-Judges, SOBHD Rules & Regulations, which reads: "During the course of a competition the comportment of the competitors may come under the jurisdiction of the judges, not only whilst dancing, but also when entering or leaving the platform and whilst waiting for the dance to start. Any unseemly behaviour on the part of a competitor or any misdemeanour likely to upset the decorum of the proceedings may be penalised by the judges and could lead to disqualification. A full report of any such misconduct on the part of a competitor must be submitted by the judges to the organiser."
14. The committee reserves the right to appoint substitute adjudicators and/or alter the program at any time.
15. Distribution of prizes will be left to the discretion of the Committee.
16. For presentation of prizes on stage, dancers must be in kilt or national costume & wearing competitor's number. For Championship presentation, dancers must wear kilt.
**Following the awards, parents may photograph their own child or others with parental permission, but be highly aware that there must not be other children in shot whose privacy must be protected.
17. Definitely NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY will be allowed whilst the dancers are competing.
18. VIDEO EQUIPMENT ... Videoing will be permitted with the following proviso – Only own child or pupil can be filmed and AT NO TIME will the film be accepted as evidence when protesting adjudication. Videoing must not hinder the dancers, adjudicators or officials.
19. **NO SMOKING IS ALLOWED AT THE COMPETITION VENUE.**
20. TITLES ... Dancers may choose to compete in all or some of the individual dances that make up a Title and will still be eligible for an overall title prize – however the full title fee will still apply. Individual prizes in each title dance will be awarded.
22. ENTRIES CLOSE ... 1st November 2018; late entries will attract an additional fee of \$5.00 per dancer.
ENTRY FEES ... No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by fees.
Dancer entry fees as per entry form. There is no hall entry for spectators on the day.
