**9:15am for Novice**, starting with 4 step Highland Fling  
*Primary dancers will be finished mid-morning.*  
*Beginners dancers only dancing the two Flings will be finished late morning.*

## COMPETITION RULES

1. This competition is registered with the South Queensland Regional Committee of Highland Dancing Inc (S.Q.R.C.H.D.I.) – Reg.No. SQC 19/04. This competition will be conducted under the rules and conditions of the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing (S.O.B.H.D) and as adopted by the Australian Board of Highland Dancing Inc (A.B.H.D.I.).
2. Dancers are to compete in their own age group and in one classification only. If, after submitting an entry, a competitor changes classification, the COMPETITION SECRETARY must be notified of the change PRIOR to the competition date (5<sup>th</sup> May 2019).
3. Any complaint made by an individual against the organisation or adjudication of an event must be made in writing, giving the complainants full name and address, and shall be lodged with the organiser (if possible on the day of the event) not later than 48 hours after the event. Such a complaint to be accompanied by a fee of \$5.00 which is refundable if protest is upheld.
4. Subject to the official protest rule above, the Adjudicator's decision is final.
5. Dancers compete entirely at their own risk.
6. Competitors arriving late for a dance will not be allowed to compete if the dance has been completed or pre-dance prior to the commencement of the section.
7. Teachers, interested parties or any other unauthorised person must not communicate with judges during a competition. All enquiries must be made at the official table.
8. During the course of the competition the comportment and behaviour of the competitors may come under the jurisdiction of the judges, not only whilst dancing, but also when entering or leaving the platform and whilst waiting for the dance to start. Any unseemly behaviour on the part of a competitor or any misdemeanour likely to upset the decorum of the proceedings may be penalised by the judges and could lead to disqualification. A full report of any such misconduct on the part of a competitor must be submitted by the judge to the organiser. In serious cases, the judge should also provide a report of any such conduct on the part of the competitor to the organiser and to the SOBHD. (*Rule 1g, p42 D-Judges, SOBHD Rules and Regulations*)
9. The committee reserves the right to appoint substitute adjudicators and/or alter the program.
10. For presentation of prizes on stage, dancers must be in kilt or national costume. Competitor's number must be worn.
11. Definitely NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY will be allowed whilst the dancers are competing.
12. VIDEO EQUIPMENT ... Videoing will be permitted with the following proviso – Only own child or pupil can be filmed and AT NO TIME will the film be accepted as evidence when protesting adjudication. Videoing must not hinder the dancers, adjudicators or officials.
13. **NO SMOKING IS ALLOWED AT THE COMPETITION VENUE.**
14. TITLES ... Dancers may choose to compete in all or some of the individual dances that make up a Title and will still be eligible for an overall title prize – however the full title fee will still apply. Individual prizes in each title dance will be awarded.
15. ENTRIES CLOSE ... We would appreciate all entries to be accepted by 6<sup>th</sup> April. However, we will accept late entries. Age groups will be decided on 13<sup>th</sup> April 2019.
