Gympie Highland Rush**COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS: 9th October 2021**

1	This competition is registered with the South Queensland Regional Committee of Highland Dancing Inc Reg. No. SQC 21/13 & will be conducted under the rules & conditions as set by the RSOBHD & adopted by the ABHDI.
2	Any rules pertaining to the competition released by RSOBHD or ABHDI from the time of printing this schedule & actual date of the competition will be adhered to.
3	Dancers must be registered and present registration card on day of Competition.
4	Age to be taken as at the date of competition SQC 2021/13 - 9 th October 2021.
5	Dancers are to compete in their own age group and in one classification only.
6	Dancers entering sections when ineligible shall forfeit their entry fee.
7	<i>Dancers who change classification, after submitting an entry for this competition must notify the organiser as soon as possible prior to this competition.</i>
8	Dancers to compete entirely at their own risk
9	PRE-PREMIER: Eligibility for Pre-Premier section will apply as at day of competition & shall be in accordance with RSOBHD registration scheme.
10	PREMIER with RESTRICTION: eligibility in this section is defined as a Premier dancer who has not placed 1 st , 2 nd or 3 rd in a registered Championship since 9 th October 2018.
11	Competitors must use the official music and swords provided by the organiser.
12	Dancers are requested to observe the ABHDI direction regarding standard of dress whilst in attendance at Highland Dancing competitions. If dancers choose to remove any part of their costume whilst not competing, it is requested they <i>be modestly attired at all times.</i>
13	Competitors arriving late for a section will not be allowed to compete if the section has finished and competitors may not pre-dance prior to commencement of section.
14	For presentation of prizes on stage, <i>dancers must be in Kilt or National Costume and competition number must be worn.</i>
15	During the course of a competition the comportment of the competitors may come under the jurisdiction of the judges, not only whilst dancing, but also when entering or leaving the platform and whilst waiting for the dance to start. Any unseemly behaviour on the part of a competitor or any misdemeanour likely to upset the decorum of the proceedings may be penalised by the judges and could lead to disqualification. A full report of any such misconduct on the part of a competitor must be submitted by the judges to the organiser. In serious cases, the judge should also provide a report of any such conduct on the part of the competitor to the organiser & to the RSOBHD.
16	Subject to the official protest ruling, <i>the Adjudicator's decision is final.</i>
17	Any complaint made by an individual against the organisation or adjudication of an event, must be made in writing, giving the complainants full name and address, and shall be lodged with the organiser (<i>if possible on the day of the event</i>) & certainly not later than 48 hours after the event. The complaint must be accompanied by a set as determined by the ABHD which is refundable if the protest is upheld. Current fee is \$5.
18	The committee reserves the right to refuse entries, appoint substitute adjudicators or to amend the program at their discretion.
19	Refunds will only be given with a medical certificate and if competition organisers have been notified in writing prior to the event. No refunds will be given if the dancer doesn't meet this criteria or doesn't dance on the day.
20	'Bonnie Skye Dancers' is not liable for the safety of unaccompanied dancers and unsupervised non-dancers.
21	'Bonnie Skye Dancers' Risk Management Strategy will be in force and will be available for anyone who wishes to peruse this document

PHOTOGRAPHY:

- Unauthorised use of cameras, imaging and digital devices is prohibited, including recording using mobile phones. It is prohibited to use any device capable of recording or transmitting visual images without the organiser's permission.
- Following the awards parents may photograph their own child or other children with parental permission but be highly aware that there must not be other children in shot whose privacy must be protected.
- (If applicable) As organisers of this event, we plan to photograph winning competitors for the purpose of posting on our Website or Facebook page. If anyone wishes to opt out of this process, please let us know.

VIDEO TAPING: is permitted with the following proviso – Only own child or pupil can be filmed and at no time will the film or video be accepted as evidence when protesting judging.

NO SMOKING: In the competition venue or on the school grounds.

1	The organisers of this competition reserve the right to refuse entry to any attendee who does not comply with the COVID-19 Rules & Regulations
2	Please do not attend this competition if: a. In the last 14 days you have travelled from overseas or a COVID-19 hotspot. b. You have been in close contact with a person who is a positive for COVID-19 c. You are an active COVID-19 case d. You are currently, or have recently experienced a cough; fever; sore throat; fatigue; loss of smell or taste; vomiting; diarrhea or shortness of breath e. You have had a COVID-19 test & have not yet received the result.
3	If you develop any flu-like symptoms during the competition, please inform the organiser immediately.
4	Please follow directions regarding designated entry and exit points.

11	Sneeze or cough into your arm or a tissue and please pit the tissue in the bin.
12	Wear a face mask if directed to do so by government authorities at the time of the competition.
13	Awards and trophy presentations may be modified to minimise handling of prizes and contact with others.
14	Please leave promptly at the end of the competition and avoid gathering in groups within or outside the venue.
