RULES AND CONDITIONS – Saturday 15th May 2021

1. This competition is registered with the South Queensland Regional Committee of Highland Dancing Inc. Reg. No. SQC 2021/06 & C 08/2021 and will be conducted under the rules and conditions as set down by RSOBHD and adopted by ABHDI.
2. Dancers must be registered and present registration card on the day of competition.
3. Age to be taken as at date of competition (SQC 2021/06 – 15/05/2021).
4. Dancers are to compete in their own age group and one classification only.
5. First to enter, last to dance.
6. **PRE-PREMIER** - Eligibility for Pre-Premier section will apply as at date of competition and shall be in accordance with RSOBHD registration scheme.
7. **PREMIER WITH RESTRICTION** – These dances are restricted to Premier dancers who have not been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a Registered Championship since 15/05/2018. Dancers may compete in Premier with Restriction dances or Premier dances, but cannot compete in both.
8. **MORETON BAY PRE-CHAMPIONSHIP** – Entry is restricted to those PREMIER dancers who have never won a Championship or a Pre-Championship.
9. **TITLES** – Dancers may choose not to compete in all dances that make up the title and still be eligible for an overall title prize, however, the full title fee still applies.
10. Dancers compete entirely at their own risk.
11. Dancers arriving late for a section will not be allowed to compete if the dance has been completed. Alternatively, competitors may not pre-dance prior to the commencement of a section.
12. Dancers must 'fill in' if requested by the organiser. If a competitor fails to fill in unless for a medical reason the organiser has the right to enforce Rule 1g), Page 45 D-Judges, RSOBHD Rules and Regulations, which reads: 'During the course of a competition the comportment and behaviour of the competitors may come under the jurisdiction of the judges, not only whilst dancing, but also when entering or leaving the platform and whilst waiting for the dance to start. Any unseemly behaviour on the part of a competitor or any misdemeanour likely to upset the decorum of the proceedings may be penalised by the judges and could lead to disqualification. A full report of any such misconduct on the part of a competitor must be submitted by the Judge to the Organiser. In serious cases, the Judge should also provide a report of any such conduct on the part of the competitor to the Organiser and to the RSOBHD'.
13. Dancers entering sections when ineligible shall forfeit their entry fee.
14. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries, substitute an Adjudicator and/or alter the program at their discretion.
15. Subject to the official protest ruling, the Judge's decision is final.
16. Any complaint made by an individual against the organisation or the adjudication of an event must be in writing stating the complainant's full name and address and be lodged with the organiser, if possible on the day of the event, and no later than 48 hours after the event. Such a complaint is to be accompanied by a fee of \$5.00, which is refundable if the protest is upheld.
17. For presentation of prizes, dancers must be in Kilt or National Costume. Competition numbers must be worn for prize giving ceremony. For presentation of Moreton Bay Pre-Championship, dancers must be dressed in Kilt, wearing their Pre-Championship number.
18. Video equipment and Photography – **DEFINITELY NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY** is allowed whilst dancers are competing. Videoining is permitted with the following proviso – Only own child or pupil can be filmed and at no time will the film or video be accepted as evidence when protesting judging. Unauthorised use of cameras, imaging and digital devices is prohibited, including recorded using mobile phones. It is prohibited to use any device capable of recording or transmitting visual images without the organiser's permission. Following the awards, parents/carers may photograph their own child or other children with parental permission but must be highly aware that there must not be other children in shot whose privacy must be protected. As organisers of this event, we plan to photograph competitors for the purpose of posting on our Website and/or Facebook page. If anyone wishes to opt out of this process, please advise the Organiser.
19. If after submitting an entry a competitor changes classification, the Entries Secretary must be notified, as soon as practicable, **PRIOR** to competition day.

7. Dancers compete entirely at their own risk.
8. Dancers arriving late for a section will not be allowed to compete if the dance has been completed. Alternatively, competitors may not pre-dance prior to the commencement of a section.

1st - 137 pts, 2nd - 91pts, 3rd - 71pts, 4th - 53pts, 5th - 37pts, 6th - 23pts.
15. For presentation of prizes, dancers must be in Kilt or National Costume. Competition numbers must be worn for prize giving ceremony. For presentation of Moreton Bay Championships, dancers must be dressed in Kilt, wearing their Championship number. For presentation of Moreton Bay Premierships, dancers must be dressed in National Costume (Aboyne), wearing their Premiership number.
16. Video equipment and Photography – **DEFINITELY NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY** is allowed whilst dancers are competing. Videoing is permitted with the following proviso – Only own child or pupil can be filmed and at no time will the film or video be accepted as evidence when protesting judging.
