

How the stickers and timelines for Registration Cards from 2021 will work:

- When dancers are re-registering for 2021, they forward their registration card (and relevant paperwork) to their State/Regional Dancer Registrar.
- The Registrar would apply the ABHDI year sticker to the existing card for the Primary and Premier dancers - and their cards can be returned.
- For the Beginner, Novice and Intermediate dancers who **have received their first stamp** but still have stamps to receive, the Registrar would apply the ABHDI year sticker and the extension sticker and **HOLD** the card until formally advised by the ABHDI of the date to be written on the sticker. If a dancer chooses to re-register during the year, the extension sticker is to have the original expiry date on the card.
- For the Beginner, Novice and Intermediate dancers who have **not yet received their first stamp** should still return their card for the extension sticker to be added. The Dancer Registrar would apply the ABHDI year sticker and the extension sticker and can be returned. The competition organiser will add the expiry date when the first stamp has been added to the card which will be 12 months from the date of the first stamp i.e. current process.
