Competition Rules

1. This competition is registered with the South Queensland Regional Committee of Highland Dancing Inc. (Reg. No. SQC21/10) and will be conducted under the rules and conditions as set down by RSOBHD and as adopted by ABHDI.
2. Dancers must be registered and present their registration card on the day of the competition.
3. Age to be taken as at the date of competition.
4. Pre-Premier - Eligibility for Pre-Premier sections will apply as at the date of competition and shall be in accordance with RSOBHD Registration Scheme.
5. RESTRICTED PREMIER – Eligibility in this section is defined as a Premier dancer who has not been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a Registered Championship since 1/1/18.
6. Dancers compete entirely at their own risk.
7. Dancers entering sections when ineligible shall forfeit their entry fee.
8. Competitors arriving late for a section will not be allowed to compete if that section has been completed.
9. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries, substitute a Judge and/or alter the programme at their discretion.
10. Subject to the official protest ruling, the Judge's decision is final.
11. Any complaint made by an individual against the Organisation or the adjudication of an event must be made in writing stating the complainant's full name and address and be lodged with the Organiser, if possible, on the day of the event, and not later than 48 hours after the event. The complaint must be accompanied by a fee of \$5.00, which is refundable if the protest is upheld.
12. For the presentation of prizes, dancers MUST be in Kilt or National Costume. Numbers must be worn for the prize-giving ceremony.
13. Photography: Unauthorised use of cameras, imaging and digital devices is prohibited, including recording using mobile phones. It is prohibited to use any device capable of recording or transmitting visual images without the organiser's permission. Following the awards parents may photograph their own child or other children with parental permission but be highly aware that there must not be other children in shot whose privacy must be protected. (If applicable) As organisers of this event, we plan to photograph winning competitors for the purpose of posting on our Website or Facebook page. If anyone wishes to opt out of this process, please let us know.
14. If after submitting an entry a competitor changes in classification: Prior to 30 July 2021 – please notify hdcomps on admin@hdcomps.com on or after 30 July 2021 - please notify competition secretary on reeltoroma@gmail.com All changes must be finalised PRIOR to competition day.
15. NO SMOKING allowed in Competition Venue.
16. The ABHDI direct that dancers use dressing rooms to change costume, and to dress fully, appropriately and respectably when in public at competitions.
17. ENTRIES CLOSE 30 July 2021. No entries will be accepted after the closing date.
18. All entries are to be submitted via hdcomps.com Email or telephone entries will not be accepted.
19. Any rules pertaining to competition or Championship, released by RSOBHD or ABHDI from the time of printing this schedule to the date of the Competition or Championship, will be adhered to.
20. During the course of a competition the comportment and behaviour of the competitors may come under the jurisdiction of the judges, not only whilst dancing, but also when entering or leaving the platform and whilst waiting for the dance to start. Any unseemly behaviour on the part of a competitor or any misdemeanour likely to upset the decorum of the proceedings may be penalised by the judges and could lead to disqualification. A full report of any such misconduct on the part of a competitor must be submitted by the judges to the organiser. In serious cases, the judge should also provide a report of any such conduct on the part of the competitor to the organiser and to the RSOBHD.

SQRCHDI COVID-19 RULES

1. The Organisers of this competition reserve the right to refuse entry to any attendee who does not comply with COVID-19 Rules and Regulations.
2. Please do not attend this competition if:
 - i. In the last 14 days you have travelled from overseas or a COVID-19 hotspot.
 - ii. Have been in close contact with a person who is positive for COVID-19.
 - iii. Are an active COVID-19 case.
 - iv. You are currently, or have recently experienced cough, fever, sore throat, fatigue, loss of smell or taste, vomiting, diarrhoea or shortness of breath.
 - v. You have had a COVID-19 test and not yet received the result
3. If you develop any flu-like symptoms during the competition, please inform the organiser immediately.
4. Please follow instructions regarding designated entry and exit points.
5. **Sign in using the QR code or sign-in sheet.**
6. Maintain 1.5 metres physical distancing wherever possible, this includes in changing and marshalling areas.
7. Dancers may consider arriving at the competition ready to dance to reduce the number of costume changes.
8. Avoid shaking hands, hugging or kissing others.
9. Please follow the organiser's guidelines with respect to food and drink.
10. Ensure appropriate hygiene including washing your hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer.
11. Sneeze or cough into your arm or a tissue. Then put the tissue in the bin.
12. Wear a face mask if directed to do so by government authorities at the time of the competition.
13. Awards and trophy presentations may be modified to minimise handling of prizes and contact with others.
14. Please leave promptly at the end of the competition and avoid gathering in groups within or outside the venue.
